

NO RENEWAL BEFORE PARAMETER

“No renewal before” parameter does not accept 0 as parameter. Setting this parameter to 0 should enable due date as the only date to renew issues. So I will set it to 1.

Renewal period	No renewal before	Automatic renewal

So, in my opinion, the issue below shows an erroneous renew date. I mean: if it is not possible to set 0 in the issuing rule, a value of 1 in the issuing rule should calculate a renew date that fits with due date. This way Staff librarians could enable renewing only in due date (now they can't) if they need it.
